From our neighbors & friends at the **Farm Service Agency of the USDA** Chemung St., Waverly # 607-565-2106 Do you have highly erodible fields that were planted or considered planted 4 out of 6 years between 2012 and 2017? Would you like to convert that land to a wildlife habitat in exchange for a sizeable annual rental payment? You could even provide a pollinator habitat, a permanent water source for the wildlife or even a food plot. Our Conservation Reserve Program (CRP), CP-1 practice establishes a perfect habitat for wildlife while also helping to reduce erosion and help the environment. Payments are based on soil type and typically range from \$50 to \$100 an acre which is paid annualy in October. • Valley Gift Certificates (VGC) are redeemable at over 100 businesses (SEE LIST)

- VGC are SOLD in denominations of \$10, \$25 and \$50 and can be purchased at:
 GVCC office, USDA/Farm Svc. office next to the GVCC office, Birdsall's Auto Works, Athens, Urban Floral, Sayre and Jayne's Flowers & Gifts, Waverly
- Each store/establishment decides how they will accept/process them in their own POS system. Many tender as gift certificate.
- Once redeemed at the store/establishment, simply send the actual VGC to Jan at the GVCC office (or drop them in office mailbox) and you will receive a check as reimbursement for the total amount.
 - NO FEES for ANYONE not the consumer, not the place of business!
